





Foreword from the District President

Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisations- an introduction



The Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisations, founded by Bhagawan Sri Sathya Sai Baba in the year 1965, is a service organisation with a spiritual core and base to benefit all mankind irrespective of religion, caste, creed or sect. The Organisation serves as a platform for its members to undertake service and other activities motivated by an urge for one's own transformation with the aim of realising one's inherent divinity.

Without any distinction of religion, nationality, race, socio-economic status, either for those who work in the Organisation or for those who are served by it, the Organisation transcends all barriers leading humanity towards the ideal of 'Fatherhood of God and Brotherhood of Man'.

The concept of fees or membership subscription is alien to the Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisations, for there cannot be any fee or subscription for one's journey towards his own self.

The organisation functions through its primary units called as Samithis and Bhajan Mandalis of which individuals - from different strata of society, different ethnic groups pursuing different religions and faiths -are members bound by the dictum of "Love all, Serve All" and pursue their own sadhana towards self-transformation following the path of selfless service to humanity.

At no point is an individual asked to follow a certain religion or rituals. On the contrary each is inspired to follow his own faith so as to ensure that a Hindu becomes a better Hindu, a Muslim becomes a better Muslim, a Christian becomes a better Christian and so on. In fact, this spiritual basis inspires everyone to pursue his own religion better by putting into practice Love and Selflessness. That is why the Organisation features in its emblem the symbols of the major religions of the world.

"The Organisations named after Me are not to be used for publicising My Name, or creating a new cult around My worship....They must render seva (service) to the helpless, the sick, the distressed, the illiterate and the needy. Their Seva (selfless service) should not be exhibitionistic; it must seek no reward, not even gratitude or thanks from the recipients. Wings of the Organisations

The Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisation functions under three wings viz. (i) Spiritual, (ii) Education, and (iii) Service.

Each activity in a wing is directed to facilitate and help the member in his own spiritual advancement. Although, the nature of activities undertaken under different wings appear to be distinct and dissimilar, but there is an inherent interrelationship amongst all the three wings. The three wings stand for Worship, Wisdom and Work.

Spirituality and Service are supplementary and complementary to each other. Spirituality is the motivational force behind service and service is the fulfillment of spirituality. Therefore, spiritual concepts learnt through education must be put into practice in form of service to humanity. Thus, in order to successfully realise the objective of joining the Sai Organisation, one must participate in activities of all the three wings.

Administration of the Organisation

Headed by an All India President who is supported by the National Vice Presidents and State Presidents, the Organisation functions like a well-oiled machine in the District under the stewardship of the District President, focused on its purpose, clear in its vision and dedicated in its efforts to live up the Swami's message – "Love All, Serve All".

The Samithis and the Bhajan Mandalis constitute a genuine spiritual movement where the members are united by a common bond – Love for God and Service to fellow human beings.

The members of the organisation work as one cohesive unit, whether as sevadals providing service at Prashanthi Nilayam, at medical camps, doing Narayan seva or the bal-vikas gurus who work with young children to inspire in them a desire to inculcate the five human values of Truth, Righteousness, Love, Peace and Non-violence, or the teachers who having undergone the training in EHV help in guiding the young minds towards the higher goals of life or the Sai Youth who work tirelessly in the Sri Sathya Sai Village Integrated Programme and Sri Sathya Sai Vidya Jyoti Programme – each of them are bound by one goal – "Service to Man is Service to God".

The 9 Point Code of Conduct and 10 Principles

Every member of the Organisation is expected to undertake Sadhana (spiritual discipline) as an integral part of his/her daily life by abiding by the following Nine Point Code of Conduct which has been bestowed by Baba for one's spiritual and personal development. In addition, the ten principles that forms the core of guidance for all the members of the Organisation as ordained by Baba himself are also produced hereunder. The nine point code of conduct and the ten principles are fundamental to the spiritual development of the members of the Sai Organisations.

Have patriotism to your nation - but do not criticise other nations or put others down. Not even in your thoughts or dreams should you think of bringing grief to your country.• Respect all religions equally.• Recognise humanity as one family - treat everyone as a family member - love all• Keep your house and surroundings clean - for this will promote hygiene and health.• Practice charity - but do not encourage beggars by giving money. Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisations, Bhadrak-1

Brief History

With the Divine blessings of our beloved Bhagawan, the Sai movement in our Dist(which was a part of Undivided Balasore Dist), started as long as in 1971. **Late Sj Biswanath Mohapatra** of Bhadrak as the president of Bhadrak samithi started Sai bhajan with a small group of people. This tiny house Bhajan centre, over a period, has developed into a big banyan tree spreading its roots and branches through the nook and corner of the present Bhadrak-1 Dist. As of today we have **43 Bhajan Mandalis** and **7 Samithis** spreading over the District. We have **122 Balvikas** centres across the district with **2232 Balvikas** students and **187 Balvikas Gurus**. The active workers comprise **1286** and around **2700** members have enrolled as members. It is our sincere endeavour to increase the number both in quantity and quality in the days to come.

Till 1993, it was under un-divided Balasore district comprising the present districts of Balasore-1, Balasore-2, Bhadrak-1 and Bhadrak-2. The Sai momentum picked up with greater speed and acceleration through the entire territory under the able guidance of the former Dist Presidents **Brahmachari Hari Narayan Das, Sj Arjun Behera, Sj Jagannath Pattanaik, Er Satchidananda Nanda, Shri Sirir Ku Das, Er Anirudha Das**. After formation of Bhadrak as Sai Dist since 1993, it started functioning under the able guidance of very devoted, dedicated and highly inspiring. Dist President **Sri Sushil Kumar Jena** under whose tenure several Bhajan Mandalis were set up and Sai movement spread to the remotest places in the district. The Contribution of **Late Sri Debananda Mohapatra, Sj Bhagirathi Nayak, Late Sj Upendra Nath Nayak, Late Sj Bhagawan Dwibedy, Late Dr Bishnu Mohan Mohapatra, Sj Sishir Kumar Ray, Late Sj Prakash Ch Das, Sj Dharani Chand, Smt Shephalika Mohapatra, Smt Pallisri Das, Late Smt Radharani Mohapatra, Smt Chayalata Das, Smt Manturani Ray** in promoting and fostering Sai movement in our district is worth mentioning. After rendering selfless service for more than a decade as Dist President, due to old age, Sri Sushil Kumar Jena, handed over the reins of Bhadrak-1 Dist to Er Sanatan Patra. With Swamis Grace and the support and enthusiastic cooperation of all brothers and sisters of Bhadrak-1 Dist, we are happy to mention here that Sai movement is progressed well in all the three wings of the organization. **Various projects like Prema Plaban Yatra, Akhanda Jyothi Yatra, Prema Sanjeevani, Amruta Bindu, SSSVIP, Holistic Health Care Seva, Sri Sathya Sai Nirmal Jhar, SRP, Vocational training centre, Sai Sabujima, Swachhata Se Dibiyata etc have been carried out successfully throughout the district with the able leadership of Er Sanatan Patra**. After a successful tenure Er Patra handed over the reins to Sj Nakul Chandra Jena in the year 2019. With the divine grace of our beloved Swami all the above projects are running smoothly with the active cooperation of the brothers and sisters of the district. Detailed report of the activities (routine and innovative) carried out during the period are enumerated below.

OVERVIEW

Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisations is functional in Bhadrak-1 with members from various cross sections of society and different faiths. With around 07 Samithis and 43 Bhajan Mandalis, the Organisation serves as a platform for its members to undertake spiritual practices through its various wings such as spiritual, education and service for their own betterment. The thrust is on self-transformation for it is only individual transformation that would ultimately lead to global transformation.

ACTIVITIES



SPECIFIC SERVICE PROJECTS OR INITIATIVES

Holistic Healthcare Seva- Bhadrak

The former State President of Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisation, Odisha Sj P. J.P Rao inaugurated the Holistic Health Care Service in Bhadrak Samithi prayer hall on 10th March 2011. Since then the health care service is continuing till today. Benevolent doctors of different faculties of Bhadrak town are coming on all Sundays and providing the service. Patients from 05 neighboring districts are provided health service from 10.03.2011. More than one lakh patients were treated in our Samithi. Free medicine and free food also being provided to the patients. With active support of doctors and Sevadals, digitisation of Sri Sathya Sai Holistic Healthcare Centre, Bhadrak was carried out by alumni of Sri Sathya Sai Educational Institutions and youth volunteers of SSSSO, Odisha on 16.12.2018. All patients were given a printed discharge summary and the data captured online for our database. This is the first step towards digitisation and standardisation of all health camps and holistic health care centres of the Sai organisation in Odisha. All the camps on every Sunday are being conducted with digitization since 16.12.2018. The complete youth brothers and sisters are serving for the complete process. Due to Covid-19 restriction the Camp could not continue physically since March 2020 till October 2021. But by the grace of Swami the first medical camp was reopened on 24.10.2021 by reverend State President Odisha Sj Narayan Prasad Sar. The Camp is continuing with covid guideline



Disaster Management

Whenever any disaster by natural calamities like flood, fire, cyclone etc affects the people of the district, the disaster team reached at the affected people with some daily needs to serve. During the month of May 2021 super cyclonic storm named “YAAS”, badly affected the people of the district. The members of Bhadrak-1 Sai District reached at the cyclone affected area and served relief materials to the people.





District Conference

The District Conference 2021 of Sri Sathya Sai Seva organisations, Bhadrak-1 was held on 31st January 2021 at Bhadrak samithi. All the office bearers of the district attended the conference. The annual action plan of the district for the year 2021 and the vision road map for 2025 prepared and offer at the lotus feet.



Samithi Conference

After the 45th State Conference and District Conference the Samithi Conference of all the 7 Samithies were organised. The conferences were organised on 13th Feb, 2021 at Rahanja of Bhadrak Samithi, on 07.03.2021 at Markona and Naguan Samithi, on 14.03.2021 at Balikhand and Kapasia Samithi, on 11.04.2021 at Tihidi and Agarpada Samithi. All the office bearers of the samithi attended the conference. The annual action plan for the year 2021 and the vision road map for 2025 were prepared and offered at the lotus feet



Vedic Movement

In our district utmost importance is given to veda chanting as is done before in any Bhajan and any programme. To improve the punctuation and intonation of vedic chants, veda workshops are being organized. Rudrapitam, Veda Purusha Parikrama , Trayee Rudram, Mass Veda Chanting in public places etc are being done on regular basis. During the pandemic the veda chanters constantly participated in the mass chanting for the welfare of the universe. On 01.04.2021 a Vedapathi Milana programme was beautifully organised at Charampa Bhajan Mandali to encourage the chanters. 
Akhand Jyothi Yatra

Nitya Narayan Seva


The nationwide lock down started on 22nd March 2020 due to Covid-19. All the market closed. Some Narayans depended on the hotels help failed to get their food in Bhadrak town. The members of Sri Sathya Sai Seva Samithi, Bhadrak could not tolerate the sorrow of these Narayans. They consulted with the District President, Bhadrak-1 to prepare the cooked food and serve the Narayans. As such the Service was started on 24.03.2020. Cooked food prepared and served to the Narayans. When it was started 4-5 Narayans were being served. Gradually the number increased. The number now reached 30. The Nitya Narayan Seva is continuing till date. During the lockdown and shutdown it was continued 2 times. But now it is continuing only at night time. By the grace of Swami and cooperation of the members of the District the service is functioning smoothly.



SAI PRASADAM

In the time of Covid-19 Pandemic, due to the nation wide lock-down, many people were in bare need of food. With the Divine guidance of our beloved Bhagawan, Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organisations, Odisha had launched **Community Kitchen** in various parts of the state in consultation with the local administration. The food prepared in these Community kitchens were handed over to the local administrations who were taking care of the distribution of food in community centers. During the second wave, micro community kitchens were set up at individual homes. In many cases, the whole family was infected with Covid and they were unable to cook food for their own self.

To cater the needs of such people, **Sai Prasadam** project was introduced. Food was being prepared and served at their door step till their complete recovery. A help line number was initiated in this regard. The Sevadals of Bhadrak-1 also participated in the Seva and served more than 150 beneficiaries.

Observation of 96th Birth Day of Bhagwan Sri Sathya Sai Baba








Sri Sathya Sai Balvikash
